Here at Holton Primary School we use the literacy scheme Read, Write, Inc. We follow the scheme Monday to Friday from 9.30 a.m. to 10.30 a.m.

The scheme aims to have all children reading fluently by teaching them a proven synthetic phonics approach whereby they learn letter sounds before blending them together to read words. They also use this phonics based approach to undertake regular writing tasks.

From Reception to Year 4 pupils are taught Read, Write, Inc. Phonics. Following rigorous assessments, children in these year groups are taught in similar ability groups by trained adults. This ensures children are learning at the level they require.

Pupils in the Juniors follow a separate scheme called Read, Write, Inc. LITERACY & LANGUAGE. This ensures these pupils are sufficiently challenged to employ their reading skills to more complex texts, often working at a level beyond primary school.
